Dear Member Districts,

An update regarding the COVID-19 federal mandate and what changes Delta Health Systems has put in place to ensure TCSIG's compliance:

With the passage of H.R.6201 - Families First Coronavirus Response Act, Federal Guidelines now mandate coverage for COVID-19 testing which states that private health plans, fully-insured and self-insured plans, are now required to provide coverage for COVID-19, which include:

- Diagnostic testing
- Cost of provider
- Urgent care center and emergency room visits (in order to receive testing)
- Any related medical services

Although, the coverage provided for testing as noted above, must be at no cost to the consumer, please note that the current mandate does not require coverage for treatment.

Accordingly, Delta Health Systems has removed the member's share of cost for the above listed services on all TCSIG plans. However, all costs related to the treatment of COVID-19 remain. (see examples below)

- Example 1. - Member on HDHP goes into a provider to get tested for COVID-19. The member's deductible and coinsurance would not apply and testing include office visit and lab work would be covered at 100% no share of cost for the member.
- Example 2. – Member on HDHP has received a diagnosis of COVID-19 and is admitted into the hospital for treatment. The member's deductible and coinsurance would apply and the member would have the same share of cost as they would any other illness.
